



The bright lights of the Strip can be mesmerizing, but when you want a vacation from your vacation, and a chance to reconnect with nature, Las Vegas Territory is waiting for you. Go from neon to nature with experiences for every age, activity level, and budget.

## BY PADDLES

For those looking to paddle through scenic canyons, kayaking on the Colorado River offers breathtaking views of Emerald Cave and access to hidden hot springs. The river's calm waters make it perfect for beginners, while longer routes challenge experienced paddlers.

Lake Mead, the largest reservoir in the U.S., offers calm waters for easy paddling and epic views of colorful desert cliffs. Boulder Basin and Callville Bay are popular launch points with hidden coves and sandy beaches to explore.

## BY WHEELS

Las Vegas Territory has 10 National and State Parks ready to explore, with more than 185 hiking/biking trails in the Las Vegas area alone. From easy, family-friendly hikes like the Historic Railroad Tunnel Trail that takes you from Boulder City to Hoover Dam, to summiting one of southern Nevada's hardest feats - Charleston Peak South Trail - adventure awaits.

### BEST TIMES FOR OUTDOOR ADVENTURES

While summer can be brutally hot, shaded canyon walls and early morning climbs make it possible to **rock climb** year-round; however, the best seasons are Fall through Spring (October-April) when temps are cool and conditions are perfect. **Kayaking, biking, and hiking** are best done in Spring (March - May) and Fall (September - November) when the weather is mild and temperatures are approx. 70°F - 90°F. These activities can also be done in the Summer and Winter months with extra precautions. During the Summer, start your adventure close to sunrise or sunset when temperatures are cooler, bringing plenty of water and sunscreen. When kayaking during the winter, be sure to wear a wetsuit to protect against colder temperatures.

## BY ROPES

If scaling rock faces is more your style, Red Rock Canyon is home to world-class rock climbing routes for all skill levels. It is one of the best sandstone climbing areas in the world with over 2,000 climbing routes, ranging from beginner-friendly sport climbs to massive multi-pitch trad routes.

For summer climbing, Mount Charleston (about an hour from Vegas) offers limestone sport climbing at higher elevations, providing a much-needed escape from the desert heat.
